Attract and Retain Highly Qualified Teachers and Maintain Small Classes

Class size reduction represents the largest portion of Measure M expenditures with 45.5-percent of the parcel tax fund equaling \$1,741,763. Measure M funding has allowed the District to maintain the following ratio of students to teacher:

- 24:1 for K-3;
- 30:1 for Middle Schools; and
- 31:1 for High Schools.

Measure M provides the supplemental funding necessary to maintain 29 full-time equivalent (FTE) teacher positions in the elementary schools and fully fund			

- Instructional Assistants in the computer labs to support existing labs and aging equipment;
- Academic web-based programs Study Island and Accelerated Reader;
- Memory upgrades, toner, splitters, battery packs, and other required supplies;
- Two computers at Marilyn Avenue Elementary (one for the Librarian and another for a 2nd Grade classroom);
- Projector and ink cartridges at Sunset Elementary;
- Document camera, printers, and computers at Junction Avenue K-8 School;
- Repair Teacher laptops and repair/replace worn out printers at Joe Michell K-8 School;
- Christensen Middle School and East Avenue Middle School updated their computer labs to the newest operating system;
- District supporting Innovative Grants, providing iPads for Project Lead the Way, computers for specific intervention program needs, and memory upgrades to extend existing computer life; and
