April 23, 2024 - Livermore, CA - The Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District Board of Education invites the Livermore community to provide feedback and input through a community survey to support their efforts in finding a new superintendent to lead LVJUSD after the retirement of Superintendent Chris Van Schaack at the end of the 2023-24 school year.
